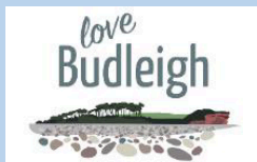

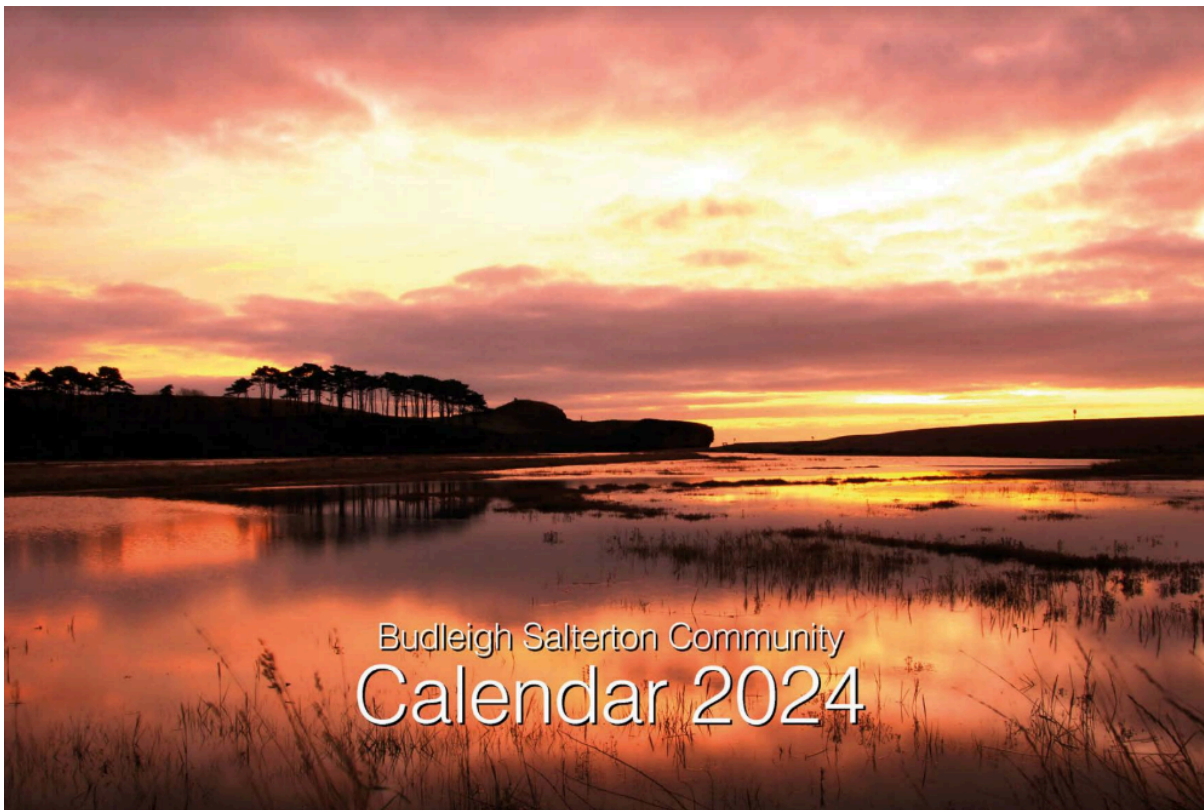

Abele Tree House



The Coach House, The Doctor's Rooms and Ensuite Bedrooms

Abele Tree House offers recently refurbished holiday accommodation in the centre of Budleigh Salterton - directly opposite the Budleigh Information Centre.

The lovely Edwardian seaside house is within 150 metres of the beach and the South West Coastal path. Minutes away from the local shops, the many excellent cafes and take-aways but quietly situated within its own grounds.

The Coach House is a separate building and was originally built to house the horses and carriages. Now newly converted, it offers a hall, kitchen/dining/sitting room, large double bedroom and bathroom on the ground floor, with a second double bedroom and shower room upstairs. A courtyard garden with seating and lighting allows guests to enjoy the sea air.

The Doctor's Rooms (the house was originally built for a local doctor) is on one level with its own entrance. It has a useful hall, kitchen/dining/sitting area, double bedroom and easy access shower.

The spacious three ensuite bedrooms are in the main house and have new bathrooms and either king size or twin beds. The family room also has bunkbeds for two children.

Pebble Cottage



Pebble Cottage, in the centre of Budleigh, sleeps two, is the perfect seaside holiday retreat in a fantastic location situated just yards from the Beach and the fabulous Jurassic Coast.

This traditional cob cottage combines old world charm with modern comforts and has a secure sunny courtyard as well as private off-road car parking.
